If you've never gone to the track, never raced on one, and/or never run in a bracket race or heads up race. This is the time to go. You'll be with a lot of people that are also new to the track as well. There will also be a lot of people that are willing to help with any questions you might have about racing. Bring all the newbies you want.

\*STREET CLASSES - We will be teching the cars to assure they have proper tags, current insurance, DOT tires and mufflers (hooked up) for all Street Class events. If you can not supply this, you will NOT be eligible to enter any of the Street Class trophy races. HOWEVER, you will be able to run your race cars during the Open Run times and in the Outlaw bracket race. We would like to encourage you to consider running your tow vehicles during the Street Legal races. In bracket racing, it's the driver, not the car. Dealer plates will not be considered as a registration for the street car qualification.

Burnout Contest Rules:

- Burn out duration will have a maximum of 30 seconds.
- Driver will then be instructed, by a Burn-Out official, to start his burnout, by countdown from the number three (3).
- The Burnout time limit will be thirty (30) seconds, beginning at the start signal, and ending with the Burnout official waving the driver on.
- Snap on hub caps, beauty rings and other loose items on the drive wheels must be removed.
- If any entry vehicle posses line lock, it should be engaged in addition to the burn area stop/chock devices.
- Each Judge will give a 1-10 score after each burnout. Scores will be tallied to declare the winners.
- Any businesses donating prizes for the competition will be allowed to enter one representative to judge the competition.
